- ICs have worked together on research agendas, so they are global agenda setters for the entire topics and should be heard in preparation of the call
- ICs are important matchmaking platforms to start project consortia together with industry partners

- The Gathering of MI ICs will give the possibility to present the activities of the ICs to the Austrian stakeholders from industry and research, as well as to network among the different ICs.
- Participants of ICs will hold a meeting to prepare for the announcement of the first MI multilateral call in Vancouver, including a matchmaking event, together with the ICs and the funding program owners / managers and hear their opinions in regards of topics to be covered in the call.


