This event marks two important launches for the Mission – the announcement of the Mission's strengthened 2030 goals and the launch of the report "Oceans of Opportunity: Supplying Zero-Emission Marine Fuels at Ports". The report is exploring strategies global ports can take to supply green methanol and ammonia this decade, where fuels are likely to be produced and sourced, and detailed case studies on how ports of Rotterdam, Singapore, Algeciras, Corpus Christi, and Seattle and Tacoma are approaching zero-emission bunkering.
